
Patterson Pouch Color Change Guide

Below is a color change guide that should help in the interpretation of the color change that occurs when the pouches are processed in an autoclave, or ethylene oxide sterilization chamber.

Caution: the chemical indicators are to be used as a sterilization process indicator only.

The indicators should be used in conjunction with biological indicators (spore strips) to ensure the devices within the pouches are sterile.

Each strip has a starting color and a finishing color. Ideally, the indicator should change from the first box to the last box, but this is often not the case due to the large variation in sterilization chambers. Therefore, we've suggested an acceptable range of color change. See diagrams below for details.
